RESOLUTION NO. 2014-36 INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A GRANT UNDER THE "2014 OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) PROGRAM", AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio, wishes to continue to provide a School Resource Officer (SRO) to the South Euclid-Lyndhurst City School District; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary to apply for a grant under the "2014 Officer of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Program" to assist in providing such services. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funds for providing a School Resource Officer (SRO) under the "2014 Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Program."
- **SECTION 2.** The Mayor and the Chief of Police are hereby authorized and directed to enter such agreements as may be necessary for the application for and receipt of such Grant Funds and related funding, as provided by law. Said agreements shall be in substantially the form as approved by the Director of Law.
- **SECTION 3.** The City is authorized to accept such funds if and when the same are awarded to the City.
- SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 5.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and health for the reason that a vital function of the municipal government is effected thereby. Therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allow by law.
