

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-53
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

AN ORDINANCE PARTIALLY SUSPENDING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE SALE, POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER AND WINE AT THE LYNDHURST PARK DURING LYNDHURST HOME DAYS FOR 2014 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. Any prior Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the sale, possession and consumption of beer and wine shall be allowed at the Lyndhurst Park during Lyndhurst Home Days on September 5, 6 and 7, 2014, provided such sale, possession and consumption complies with all applicable laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirement of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst for the reason that the ordinance enacted herein is necessary to complete preparations for a successful Home Days event which begins on September 5, 2014. It shall therefore, take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
