

ORDINANCE 2015-12
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHAGRIN VALLEY ENGINEERING, LTD. TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES FROM JANUARY 1, 2015, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Lyndhurst has appointed Jeff Filarski as the Engineer for the City, pursuant to Chapter 147 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Jeff Filarski is a partner at the engineering firm of Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndhurst wishes to engage Jeff Filarski and the engineering firm of Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd., to perform engineering services beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2016. Now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Jeff Filarski shall continue to be employed as the Engineer for the City for the period beginning January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2016 at a salary to be determined annually by Council. The City Engineer shall perform the duties imposed by Charter and Ordinances of the City of Lyndhurst, and by State law.

SECTION 2. The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement to engage the engineering firm of Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. to provide engineering services in connection with various matters at the rates set out in the letter dated January 22, 2015, which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to provided continued engineering services for the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
