**A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR HALLOWEEN  
OBSERVANCE UPON THE STREETS AND OUT-OF-  
DOORS FOR OCTOBER 31, 2016, BETWEEN THE  
HOURS OF 6:00 P.M. AND 8:00 P.M.**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,  
CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** Halloween activities and observances in the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio, in the year 2016 shall take place on Monday, October 31, 2016. The custom generally known as "trick or treating" shall be permitted only between the hours of 6:00 and 8:00 P.M., and the canvassing which is part of said custom shall be subject to parental supervision. Disorderly conduct and peace disturbances as provided for in Chapter 648 of the Codified Ordinances are prohibited.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, peace, welfare, and safety of the City of Lyndhurst for the reason that most communities in and around Lyndhurst will observe Halloween on the same day, thereby eliminating the possibility of misunderstanding among children who may go from one community to another. Wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
