**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING COMMENDATION AND SINCERE APPRECIATION TO STACEY O'BRIEN FOR DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF LYNDHURST AS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP ON AGING**
