

ORDINANCE NO. 2017 - 38
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF
SICK LEAVE SEVERANCE UPON RETIREMENT TO THE
SERVICE DIRECTOR FOR YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE
RESIDENTS OF LYNDHURST**

WHEREAS, Frederick E. Glady III began his employment with the City of Lyndhurst on June 4, 1978; and

WHEREAS, Frederick E. Glady III qualified for and accepted service retirement under OPERS on August 31, 2009, and then immediately continued service to the City of Lyndhurst as a part-time Service Director without a break in service; and

WHEREAS, Frederick E. Glady III received payment for accrued and unused sick leave upon service retirement under OPERS pursuant to Section 159.11(f) of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Frederick E. Glady III, in his position as part-time Service Director from September 1, 2009 to June 30, 2017, continued to accrue sick leave pursuant to Section 159.11(a) of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, this Council, the Mayor and Administration wish to acknowledge the dedication of Frederick E. Glady III to the City and to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, Frederick E. Glady III shall, upon retirement from the City of Lyndhurst as part-time Service Director, receive payment for his accrued and unused sick leave accumulated while serving as part-time Service Director. Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. This Council, the Mayor and Administration wish to acknowledge the dedication of Frederick E. Glady III to the City and to the residents of the City.

SECTION 2. This Council determines that Frederick E. Glady III, upon retirement from the City of Lyndhurst as part-time Service Director, shall receive payment for his accrued and unused sick leave accumulated while serving as part-time Service Director from September 1, 2009, to June 30, 2017.

SECTION 3. The Director of Finance is directed to calculate the amount of such payment, and to make such payment to Frederick E. Glady III within thirty (30) days of his last day of service.

SECTION 4. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
