

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-28**  
**INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF NOTRE DAME COLLEGE AND THE CITY OF LYNDHURST PROVIDING FOR THE EXERCISE OF POLICE POWERS IN AND AROUND NOTRE DAME COLLEGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Notre Dame College has established a campus police department, and the Board appoints members of the campus police department to act as police officers pursuant to authority granted by Ohio Revised Code Section 1713.50; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 1713.50(C) permits the board of trustees of a private college or university to enter into an agreement with any political subdivision pursuant to which the members of the campus police department of the college or university may exercise within that political subdivision, but outside the property of the college or university, the powers and authority granted to them under this division; and

**WHEREAS**, Council wishes to enter into such an agreement with Notre Dame College. Now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is authorized to enter into an Agreement with the Board of Directors of Notre Dame College to allow officers of the college to exercise their police powers within the City of Lyndhurst, and to develop protocols for the operation of those powers.

**SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare within the City for the reason that it is necessary to authorize said Agreement as soon as possible. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and signature of the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
