

Hi Everyone!

Attached is the posting for our upcoming summer Lyndhurst CERT training session!!!

We will be doing something a bit different this time around. We will conduct a "hands-on" training evolution that will be initiated by a CERT callout. What that means is we (your CERT Training Team) have set up an activity / drill / mock evolution that is designed to test us all on the skills we have been taught in all of our previous sessions. We have designed it to mimic an actual possible CERT callout situation!

This training session will be conducted (using our callout system) **sometime between 6:00 PM Friday July 16th 2010 and 8:00 PM July 18th 2010**. This time frame does not mean that you will be out there all this time, it just means that we will begin any time during this time slot. Once the drill is initiated you can plan on being involved for about four hours.

We will not be in a classroom for this training session!

Since this is a new concept for us as your training team, here is what we will need you to do;

- Decide if you will be available during the above time frame
- If you **are** available, respond back to me by 1:00 PM July 12th that you will be able to attend. In your response please include your contact phone number so we can be assured that when we initiate the callout, we will be able to contact you. **THIS IS IMPORTANT ESPECIALLY IF YOUR NUMBER HAS CHANGED RECENTLY!!**
- When you receive the call out at the time of the drill, you will be given specific instructions on where to report for the scenario. You would be expected to respond immediately after that phone call.
- This training exercise will be conducted outdoors, rain or shine, so plan accordingly!

Once the drill starts, come out and plan on having some fun!!!

If you have questions, feel free to give one of the training team members a call but since we want this to be as realistic as we can safely set up, we don't want to give out too much detail.
