

Curbside Recycling

The City of Lyndhurst Service Department would like to thank you for a very successful 2011 recycling program. With your cooperation the Service Department collected 1,425 tons of recycling in 2011 which was an increase of more than 7 tons from 2010. With your help we were able to avoid paying the \$51,000 it would have cost for disposal at the landfill and with the profit sharing contract beginning in late 2010 we received a return of \$60,000 for our single stream recycling. Revenues received from automated recycling help to lower costs of providing services to residents. We ask for your continued commitment and support in making 2012 even more successful.

**We accept phone books, magazines and paper backed books with all other plastics (1-7), metal food cans, glass bottles and jugs and paper/cardboard - just place them loosely in the blue recycling cart.

**Additional recycling that will not fit in the recycling cart can be placed in a plastic bag and set next to your blue recycling cart for pickup.

**Please remember to have all rubbish & recycling out to the curb by 7:00am the day of pickup. Due to the efficiency of the automated process we are getting many calls for late stops.

Hazardous Household Waste Disposal

Hazardous waste such as paints, pesticides and household cleaners can be dropped off at the service garage during our working hours 7:00am – 3:00pm, Monday through Friday. Beginning April 14th you can drop off your hazardous waste on the weekends during our weekend rubbish program, Saturday and Sunday from 11:30am – 3:30pm at the service garage. This program is only for Lyndhurst residents, please bring proof of residency.

Weekend Rubbish

Our weekend rubbish program will begin Saturday, April 14th from 11:30am – 3:30pm and run every Saturday and Sunday through the middle of November. This service enables residents to bring rubbish, yard waste, and hazardous household waste to the service garage for disposal. This program is only for Lyndhurst residents, please bring proof of residency.

Tire Roundup

Tires, off the rim, may be dropped off at the service garage during our weekend rubbish program during the month of September. If you would like to dispose of your tires before this time you may drop them off at a tire dealer for disposal for a fee. This program is only for Lyndhurst residents, please bring proof of residency.
