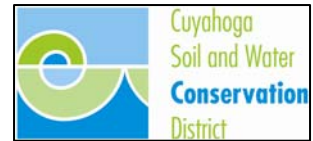

Rain Barrel Workshop in Lyndhurst

Valley View, OH – Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) will be hosting a Rain Barrel Workshop with the City of Lyndhurst and the Friends of Euclid Creek on Wednesday, June 13th from 6:30-8:00pm at the Lyndhurst Community Center. A rain barrel is a container used to collect and store rainwater that would otherwise be lost to runoff and likely diverted to a storm drain. Collected water may then be used to water lawns and gardens. Cost is \$60 (Friends of Euclid Creek members receive a \$10 discount) and includes the 60 gallon barrel, all materials and downspout diverter.
