Donors will need their donor card, a driver's license or two forms of positive identification. * or accompanied by a parent

Monday, February 18 - Safe Sitter Babysitting class 9am – 4 pm for boys & girls 11 - 13 yrs old.

Provided in partnership with the Greater Cleveland Safe Kids coalition, an affiliate of UH's Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital. [Students are taught safe childcare techniques, behavior management skills and appropriate responses to emergencies, as well as some babysitter business and job screening skills. Cost per student is \\$60.00 which includes snacks, lunch and take home materials. Pre-registration is required and will be accepted through Wed. Feb. 13, ONLY. Class size is LIMITED.](#)
