Report Suspicious Activity

It is essential for residents and community members to work in partnership with the police to reduce the risk of crime and help them apprehend violators. Report anything in your neighborhood that is out of the ordinary, arouses your suspicions, or makes you feel uncomfortable. The more information you supply and the more promptly you notify the police, the more likely it is that we will make an arrest quickly if a crime does occur. Even if you do not have all pertinent details, the little information you do provide can still be valuable. Never investigate a potentially dangerous situation yourself. Call the police.

Vehicle Security Reminder

Lock your car doors, even when parked in your driveway. Unlocked car doors are an open invitation for thieves looking for small valuables such as a purse, satellite radio, iPod, or GPS unit. If you must keep valuable items in your car, the best place is the trunk if your vehicle has one. If it does not, never leave valuables in plain view.
