Dear Neighbor:

The City of Lyndhurst will be vacuuming piles of leaves from the tree lawns. Leaf pick up will not be on a set schedule, but, instead will be on an "as needed" basis. Projection on leaf fall, at this time, indicates that vacuum pick up will start about mid - October.

All leaves that are collected from tree lawns will be composted, and made into leaf humus and other soil amendments. Therefore, it is extremely important that you place all leaves on your tree lawn in piles for vacuum pick up. At the end of the season, if you should have small quantities of leaves, please bag them in paper yard waste bags or place them in your designated yard waste container. Place the leaves curbside for pick up on your normal collection day.

Because of a safety hazard, **leaves are not to be piled in the street or gutter.** Leaves piled in this area will not be picked up, and the resident will be notified to remove the leaves or be cited (C.O. 660.03).

PILED LEAVES MIXED WITH BRANCHES OR OTHER MATERIAL WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.

We respectfully request your assistance and cooperation to ensure a successful program that, hopefully, will satisfy all of our residents.

To assist you in disposal of rubbish, facilities are presently stationed between the Service Department garages. This service will be available until the weekend of November 22nd/23rd and will resume spring of 2015.

Holiday Collection:

On the following observed Holidays, there will be NO Rubbish/Recycling pickup. If your day of collection falls on any of these Holidays, your day of collection will be the next business day.

No other day of collection will be affected by these holidays.

(Thanksgiving Day)

Thursday, November 27, 2014

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Friday, November 28, 2014, which will include Thursday's route.

(Christmas Day Observance)

Thursday, December 25, 2014

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Friday, December 26, 2014, which will include Thursday's route.

(New Year's Day Observance)

Thursday, January 1, 2015

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Friday, January 2, 2015, which will include Thursday's route.

(Memorial Day)

Monday, May 25, 2015

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Tuesday, May 26, 2015, which will include Monday's route.

(Independence Day)

Friday, July 3, 2015

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Monday, July 6, 2015, which will include Friday route.

(Labor Day)

Monday, September 7, 2015

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Tuesday, September 8, 2015, which will include Monday's route.

(Thanksgiving Day)

Thursday, November 26, 2015

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Friday, November 27, 2015, which will include Thursday's route.

(Christmas Day Observance)

Friday, December 25, 2015

Trash/Recyclables will not be picked up on this day. Trash/Recyclables will be picked up on Monday, December 28, 2015, which will include Friday's route.

Please have your rubbish on the curb by 7:00 AM.

SNOW PLOWS

Please Note: Winter is not too far away and in the very near future you will be contacted by snow plow operators regarding the plowing of your driveway this winter. The city requires all commercial snow plow operators to obtain a permit. In applying for a permit, the owner must show that his vehicles are registered as commercial vehicles, that he has liability insurance on the vehicles, and that he has the necessary emergency equipment on the vehicle.

When these requirements are met, a permit will be issued. This permit allows the operator to plow snow for a fee in the City of Lyndhurst. When the city issues this permit, it assumes no responsibility for the performance or lack of performance of the various operators.

Therefore, we are requesting that you not sign a contract prior to their showing proof that they are licensed to operate in Lyndhurst. **REMEMBER – It is illegal to deposit snow in the street or block public sidewalks while plowing, shoveling or snow blowing your driveway. Violators may be prosecuted.**
