

Sign Up for County Alerts and Information

Cuyahoga County is offering an opportunity for county residents to sign up for emergency alerts and other important information.

On Monday, March 3rd, Cuyahoga County Executive Ed FitzGerald announced the launch of the County's new mass notification system, ***ReadyNotify***. The new service, which is free to county residents, will provide users with immediate information regarding emergency events and other important information, including Cuyahoga County Government News, Cuyahoga County Building Closures, Water Boil Alerts, and Safety Messages. Registered users will be able to receive information via landline telephones, cell phones, text messages, e-mail and fax.

Registering with *ReadyNotify* will not interfere with a resident's ability to receive alerts or other information through one of the many city-operated systems in the county. *ReadyNotify* provides county-level information and is intended to supplement city-operated mass notification systems.
