Discuss Joint Original Appointment Exam in the Fire Department.

At this time a Joint Original Appointment Exam was discussed with representatives from the cities of Mayfield Heights, South Euclid and Pepper Pike.

Chief Carroll explained that a joint test was conducted in June, 2013 with Lyndhurst and Pepper Pike, and worked out well. He further stated that the costs were shared by both cities, and that Lyndhurst administered the application process, which he would like to maintain for future exams. He then stated that once the test was given and scores released, each city would add their customized extra credit points or percentages. Pepper Pike Fire Chief John Frazier, concurred.

Discussion continued, and it was the general consensus that most cities would not be ready for a joint test in the near future due to differing rules and procedures.
