

## **Public Lands & Buildings Committee**

The Public Lands & Buildings Committee met on Wednesday, December 18, 2019 in the Conference Room of the Lyndhurst Municipal Center.

Committee members present were Council members Jeff Price, David Frey and Steve Grushetsky. Also present were Council members Lane Schlessel, Joe Gambatese, Joe Marko, Chuck LoPresti, Mayor Patrick Ward, and Director of Law Paul Murphy.

Chairman Price called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, stating the purpose is to discuss accessible playground improvements in the city parks. He turned the meeting over to Mayor Ward.

Mayor Ward explained the County has a supplemental grant to help with improvements to the playgrounds making them more accessible to children for both physical and mental development. He would like to request \$50,000 to use towards the city parks. The deadline to submit an application is January 3, 2020.

The Public Lands and Building Committee unanimously agreed to make a recommendation to Council authorizing the Mayor to apply for supplemental grant funding with the County.

With no further business to discuss, it was moved by Mr. Frey, seconded by Mr. Grushetsky, that pursuant to O.R.C. 121.22 (G)(3), Council convene in Executive Session (closed to the public) to discuss pending and imminent litigation.
