

## Legislative Committee Meeting

The Legislative Committee met on January 20, 2020 at 6:45 P.M. to discuss legislation pertaining to Tattoo Parlors.

Present at the meeting were committee members Councilman David Frey, Councilman Chuck LoPresti and Councilman Joe Marko. Others present were Councilman Joe Gambatese, Councilman Jeff Price, Councilman Lane Schlessel, Councilman Steve Grushetsky, Mayor Patrick Ward and Assistant Law Director Ray Schmidlin. Law Director John Luskin was present via telephone.

Mr. Frey called the meeting to order stating the purpose of the meeting is to discuss revised legislation for tattoo parlors. He opened discussion by asking the committee members if they are ready to consider the legislation as distributed.

It was discussed to include a set back from the main road of 150 feet, and to restrict the location of such business operating within 1000 feet of a school, day care, outdoor play ground or indoor play facility.

Mayor Ward stated he is not aware of any lease currently being held.

Mr. Marko asked for the legislation to include a reference to the current loitering ordinance.

Mr. Frey commented that if a conditional use is granted, any business within 500 feet should be notified.

The committee recommended for Mr. Schmidlin to make modifications to the current ordinance regarding location and submit an updated draft for review.

The committee also made recommendation for the Little Free Library legislation to be updated to include location, distance between, and potential site restrictions. The committee deferred to the Planning Commission to help determine the distance.

Mr. Schmidlin stated he would make the necessary changes.

With no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 PM.
