

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-13**  
**INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO  
IMPLEMENT DENTAL AND LIFE INSURANCE  
COVERAGE FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,  
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement a dental insurance plan for eligible employees of the City with Assurant Employee Benefits at the monthly rate of Twenty-Five Dollars and Forty Seven Cents (\$25.47) per employee and Seventy-Eight Dollars and Twenty-Three Cents (\$78.23) per family effective March 1, 2014.

**SECTION 2.** The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to implement a life insurance plan for eligible employees with Assurant Employee Benefits at a rate of Ten Cents (\$.10) per \$1,000 for life insurance and Three Cents (\$.03) per \$1,000 for accidental death and dismemberment coverage to a maximum benefit of Two Hundred Thousand (\$200,000) dollars effective March 1, 2014.

**SECTION 3.** The rates specified above for dental coverage are for a twenty-four-month period beginning March 1, 2014. Should it become necessary to extend these coverages beyond the aforesaid twenty-four month period, Council shall approve any extension and any increase in the stated rates, if applicable.

**SECTION 4.** Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City for the reason that it is necessary to implement the aforesaid insurance coverages for the employees of the City so that the same are effective as of March 1, 2014. Therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
