

**RESOLUTION NO. 2014-52
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO JOIN THE
EASTSIDE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PARTNERSHIP
COMPOSED OF SEVERAL EAST SIDE COMMUNITIES,
PROVIDING FUNDING FOR SAID PARTNERSHIP, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Cities of Beachwood, Lyndhurst, Mayfield Heights, Pepper Pike, Shaker Heights and University Heights are creating the Eastside Wildlife Management Partnership in order to identify the impact to the region of an overabundance of deer, and to best determine how to deal with that impact; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt legislation authorizing said Partnership, and to provide initial funding for the Partnership. Now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to join, on behalf of the City of Lyndhurst, the Eastside Wildlife Management Partnership.

SECTION 2. The City of Lyndhurst is hereby authorized to pay into the Partnership its proportionate share on a per acre basis, an amount not to exceed \$6,000.00 without further action by this Council.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its residents because it is necessary to determine how to deal with the impact of the overabundance of deer in the City. This Resolution shall therefore take effect immediately upon passage of the affirmative vote of not less than five members of this Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
