

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015- 23**  
**INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION  
OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST IN A CONSORTIUM TO  
OBTAIN BIDS FOR SOLID WASTE TRANSFER AND  
DISPOSAL SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has offered to facilitate the creation of a consortium of municipalities including the Cities of Beachwood, Lyndhurst, Solon, Pepper Pike, and Warrensville Heights, and the Villages of Highland Hills, Moreland Hills and Woodmere (the Consortium), for the development of a combined invitation to bid, agreement and related bid documents, to obtain Solid Waste Transfer and Disposal Services for the participants in the Consortium; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has to prepare the invitation to bid, an agreement and related bid documents to invite bids for the simultaneous award of a contract for the Solid Waste Transfer and Disposal Services, including a recommendation by the Consortium regarding the lowest and best bid for consideration by each of the participants in the Consortium; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Lyndhurst has determined that it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to participate in the Consortium, and therefore authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District, by and on behalf of the City of Lyndhurst and the other member participants in the Consortium, to advertise and invite bids for the Solid Waste Transfer and Disposal Services required by the City. Now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Council of the City of Lyndhurst approves participation in the Consortium of municipalities formed to obtain bids for the Solid Waste Transfer and Disposal Services.

**SECTION 2.** The Council of the City of Lyndhurst requests Service Director Rick Gladly to meet with the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District and representatives of the member participants of the Consortium for the development of bid documents, the solicitation of competitive bids and the review and recommendation to Mayor Joseph M. Cicero Jr. and the Lyndhurst City Council for award of a contract to the lowest and best bidder.

**SECTION 3.** The Council of the City of Lyndhurst authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District to attach a copy of this Resolution as an exhibit to the invitation to bid documents to demonstrate that the City of Lyndhurst is a member participant of the Consortium.

**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding the participation of the City in this consortium, this Council declares that no bid or contract resulting therefrom shall be binding upon the City without further action by this Council.

**SECTION 5.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
