

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-30
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PARTICIPATE
IN A CONSORTIUM TO SOLICIT PROPOSALS FOR
RECYCLING PROCESSING SERVICES, AUTHORIZING THE
MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS ASSOCIATED
THEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, The Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has offered to facilitate the creation of a consortium, including but not limited to the City of Beachwood, the City of Cleveland Heights, the Village of Highland Hills, the City of Independence, the City of Lyndhurst, the City of Pepper Pike, the Village of Moreland Hills, the City of Shaker Heights, the City of South Euclid, the City of University Heights, the City of Warrensville Heights, and the Village of Woodmere, for the development of a combined request for proposals, agreement and related bid documents, in order to obtain recycling processing services for the participating municipalities in the consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has offered to prepare the request for proposals, agreement, and related documents to solicit proposals for the simultaneous award of a contract for the recycling processing services, including a recommendation by the consortium regarding the proposals for consideration by each of the participants in the consortium; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the City to participate in the consortium in order to solicit bids for recycling processing disposal services. Now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,
CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. This Council authorizes the City to participate in a consortium to solicit proposals for recycling processing services in the City.

SECTION 2. This Council authorizes the City's Service Director to meet with the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District and the participants in the consortium for the development of the documents and the review and recommendation to the Council for the award of the contract to a recycler.

SECTION 3. This Council authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute any and all documents necessary to complete participation in the consortium.

SECTION 4. This Council authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District to attach a copy of this Ordinance as an Exhibit to the request for proposals to demonstrate that the City of Lyndhurst is an authorized participant in the consortium.

SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the participation of the City in this consortium, this Council declares that no bid or contract resulting therefrom shall be binding upon the City without further action by this Council.

SECTION 6. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall hereby be declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst for the reason that it is necessary to solicit proposals for the recycling processing services in a timely manner in order to protect the health, welfare and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its citizens. It shall therefore take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
