

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015-6**  
**INTRODUCED BY: VICE-MAYOR LANE SCHLESSEL**

**AN ORDINANCE DETERMINING TO RESCHEDULE THE FIRST  
REGULAR MEETING OF COUNCIL IN FEBRUARY, 2015 FROM  
MONDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2015 TO MONDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2015,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Lyndhurst requires that Council shall hold at least one regular meeting in each calendar month; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 121.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Lyndhurst provides that regular meetings of Council shall be held on the first and third Monday of each month; and

**WHEREAS**, because of prior business commitments there is a question whether or not there will be a quorum available for the regular meeting scheduled for February 2, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has therefore determined to reschedule the first meeting in February, 2015 so as to ensure the presence of a quorum at that meeting. Now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,  
COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The regular meeting of Lyndhurst City Council scheduled for Monday, February 2, 2015 be rescheduled to Monday, February 9, 2015 at 8:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers.

**SECTION 2.** Adoption of this Ordinance shall not serve to amend any provision of either the Charter of the City of Lyndhurst or the Codified Ordinances of the City of Lyndhurst, except to the extent as stated above.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City for the reason that it is necessary to reschedule the meeting as soon as possible so all necessary parties may be informed according to law. Therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
