

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-28
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00 FOR THE MAYFIELD ROAD STOREFRONT RENOVATION PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT EVIDENCING SUCH APPROVAL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City has applied to Cuyahoga County for financial assistance under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 in the amount of \$50,000.00 to fund a project activity known as the Mayfield Road Storefront Renovation Program; and

WHEREAS, the application has been approved, and requires acceptance by Council in the form of an Agreement with Cuyahoga County. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Lyndhurst does hereby accept financial assistance from Cuyahoga County under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 in the amount of \$50,000.00.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is hereby directed to execute a General Agreement for acceptance of said financial assistance on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3. Said financial assistance shall be used to fund the Mayfield Road Storefront Renovation Program.

SECTION 4. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its residents. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
