

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-94
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA FOR SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FUNDING TO BE USED FOR STOREFRONT IMPROVEMENT WITHIN THE MAYFIELD ROAD BUSINESS DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, certain areas within the Mayfield Road Business District Corridor in the City of Lyndhurst have been designated as Target Improvement Areas or contain storefronts in need of updating; and

WHEREAS, improvements made to storefront facades along the Mayfield Road Business corridor during the calendar years 2017 and 2018 have already positively influenced tenancy and the community aesthetic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndhurst is planning application for additional grant funds to facilitate the influence of further improvements along the Mayfield Road Business Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lyndhurst wishes to memorialize its support of the City's efforts to positively influence, by use of grant funds, the continued improvement of storefront facades along the Mayfield Road Business District Corridor in the City. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: This Council, on behalf the residents of the City of Lyndhurst, makes recommendation to the Mayor and the City Administration to make application for grant funding to specifically facilitate further needed improvements of storefronts along the Mayfield Road Commercial Business District Corridor for the calendar year 2019.

SECTION 2: The Mayor, Patrick A. Ward be and he is hereby requested to cause a fully executed duplicate of this Resolution be transmitted to Cuyahoga County officials as part of the City's application for grant funding.

SECTION 3: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio for the reason that it is necessary to make application for Grant Funding without delay. Therefore this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
