

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-116
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA FOR SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FUNDING TO BE USED FOR PHASE 2 OF PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY PARKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2019-101, adopted by the Council of the City on December 18, 2019, authorized the Mayor to make application for grant funding to specifically facilitate the addition of accessible and/or inclusive playground equipment in City parks for the calendar year 2020, which was successfully granted by Cuyahoga County Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lyndhurst is planning application for additional grant funds to facilitate the further addition of fitness equipment in City parks for the calendar year 2021 which will be phase 2 of this initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Lyndhurst wishes to memorialize its support of the City's efforts to positively influence, by use of grant funds, further making the parks usable and accessible for all resident with the addition of fitness equipment in City parks. Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1: This Council, on behalf the residents of the City of Lyndhurst, makes recommendation to the Mayor and the City Administration to make application for grant funding to specifically facilitate phase 2 of the accessible and/or inclusive playground/fitness equipment in City parks for the calendar year 2021.

SECTION 2: The Mayor, Patrick A. Ward be and he is hereby requested to cause a fully executed duplicate of this Resolution be transmitted to Cuyahoga County officials as part of the City's application for grant funding.

SECTION 3: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst, Ohio for the reason that it is necessary to make application for Grant Funding without delay. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
