

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-24
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE TERMS OF
RECIPROCITY WITH THE CITY OF SOUTH EUCLID DURING
THE 2020 POOL SEASON**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LYNDHURST, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. Conditioned on reciprocity rights being granted by the City of South Euclid to Lyndhurst residents who are season swimming pass holders, South Euclid residents who are swimming pass holders of that City will be permitted the use of the Lyndhurst swimming pool during open swim season only, and the use of the Brainard Spray Park at all times it is open. In the case where the cost of a Lyndhurst season swimming pass exceeds the cost of a South Euclid season swimming pass, the South Euclid season swimming pass holder may access the Lyndhurst facilities on a seasonal basis by paying to the City of Lyndhurst Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for a single pass and Sixty Dollars (\$60.00) for a family pass, and receiving a Lyndhurst photo identification to be shown for entry to Lyndhurst pool facilities.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees resulting in such formal action took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
