

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-3
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH A COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS COMPOSED OF THE CITIES OF SOUTH EUCLID, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, LYNDHURST, MAYFIELD HEIGHTS AND RICHMOND HEIGHTS, AND THE VILLAGE OF MAYFIELD, PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP ON AGING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in 1978 the Cities of South Euclid, Lyndhurst and Highland Heights entered into a Council of Governments Agreement creating the Tri-City Consortium on Aging; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement has been amended by the parties to add the City of Mayfield Heights and the Village of Mayfield as members, and to change the name to the Community Partnership on Aging (CPA); and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the member communities to continue the CPA and to add the City of Richmond Heights as an additional member, and to set out the rights, duties and obligations of each member. Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a Council of Governments Agreement with the Cities of South Euclid, Highland Heights, Mayfield Heights and Richmond Heights, and the Village of Mayfield, in a format attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. As stated in the Agreement, the Tri-County Consortium on Aging shall be known as the Community Partnership on Aging (CPA).

SECTION 3. The City of Lyndhurst is hereby authorized to pay into the CPA its proportionate share on a per capita basis, as calculated pursuant to the Agreement, but in no respect shall such proportionate share exceed One Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Dollars (\$155,000.00) without further action by this Council.

SECTION 4. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its residents because it is necessary to maintain the Community Partnership on Aging without interruption and shall therefore take effect immediately upon passage of the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of this Council or the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
