

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-45

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PARTICIPATE
IN A CONSORTIUM TO OBTAIN BIDS FOR RECYCLING
PROCESSING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has offered to facilitate the creation of a Consortium among various communities in Cuyahoga County to obtain bids for Recycling Processing Services for participants in the Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District has agreed to prepare all bid documents and to invite bids on behalf of the Consortium for the simultaneous award of a contract for Recycling Processing Services by each Consortium participant; and

WHEREAS, the Consortium participants will review the bids to determine the lowest and best bid and recommend a successful bidder for a contract award; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lyndhurst has determined it is in the best interest of the City and its residents to participate in the Consortium and authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District, by and on behalf of the City of Lyndhurst and the other participants in the Consortium, to advertise and Invite Proposals for the Recycling Processing Services required by the City of Lyndhurst. Now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST,
CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

SECTION 1. The City Council of Lyndhurst approves the participation of the City of Lyndhurst in a Consortium to obtain proposals for Recycling Processing Services.

SECTION 2. The City Council of Lyndhurst authorizes, Service Director, Anthony Fioritto, to meet with the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District and the participants in the Consortium for the development of proposal documents and the review and recommendation to the City of Lyndhurst of the successful contractor.

SECTION 3. The City Council of Lyndhurst authorizes the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District to attach a copy of this Resolution as an Exhibit to the request for proposal to demonstrate the City of Lyndhurst authorized participation in the Consortium.

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding the participation of the City in this Consortium, this Council declares that no bid or contract resulting therefrom shall be binding upon the City without further action by this Council.

SECTION 5. The City Council of Lyndhurst authorizes and directs the Mayor to execute all documents necessary to complete participation in the Consortium.

SECTION 6. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall hereby be declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Lyndhurst for the reason that it is necessary to solicit proposals for the recycling processing services in a timely manner in order to protect the health, welfare and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its citizens. It shall therefore take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
