

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-47

**A RESOLUTION GOVERNING THE USE AND RESERVATION OF
PARK PAVILION FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF LYNDBURST
ESTABLISHING FEES AND RULES FOR USE AND DECLARING AN
EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Parks in the City of Lyndhurst have been outfitted with picnic pavilion facilities for resident use, and

WHEREAS, Resident use is often preempted by non-resident users, and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to establish a process for reserving picnic pavilion facilities in the City by residents as well as establishing guidelines and a fee schedule governing each use.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDBURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE: Picnic Pavilions must be available for reservation by Residents Only for use by that resident and their guests.

SECTION TWO: The Mayor is requested to work with Council's Public Lands and Buildings Committee to establish appropriate guidelines, a fee schedule and a reservation process for use of picnic pavilion facilities in the City's parks and to modify said regulations as needed.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City for the reason that it is necessary to implement the aforesaid so that the same is effective, and the services can be provided immediately. Therefore, this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
