

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-60
INTRODUCED BY: ADMINISTRATION

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE RECEIPT OF
FEDERAL FUNDS DISTRIBUTED AS PART OF THE
CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF AND ECONOMIC SECURITY
(CARES) ACT, ESTABLISHING A SPECIFIC FUND NAMED
THE “LYNDHURST CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND”
ACCOUNTING FOR THE RECEIPT AND USE OF SAID FUNDS
CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS SET FORTH BY
THE LEGISLATURE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, The Federal Government has provided for relief from impacts resulting from the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic in the form of funding distributed to the respective States for ultimate distribution to affected Counties and municipalities; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Treasury has established guidelines governing the use of said funds consistent with the intentions of Congress; and

WHEREAS, The State of Ohio has determined the best and most expedient manner to distribute funds to local municipalities based upon the FY 2019 Local Government Fund (LGF) allocation; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Administration and Council of the City of Lyndhurst to receive said funds to be used for the purposes and in the manner so prescribed by the United States Treasury and the Ohio Legislature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. This Council of the City of Lyndhurst agrees to receive subject CARES Act Funding to cover those costs consistent with Section 5001 of the CARES Act as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d) and applicable regulations and under guidelines established by the U.S. Treasury .

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby directed to receipt said funds into a restricted Lyndhurst Coronavirus Relief Fund of the City from which said funding may be appropriated for the established specific purposes.

Section 3. Monies not expended or encumbered from the Lyndhurst Coronavirus Relief Fund by October 15, 2020, or any later date established by the Legislature, shall be remitted back to the Treasurer of Cuyahoga County.

Section 4. The Clerk of Council is directed to provide fully executed copies of this Legislation to the Treasurer of Cuyahoga County and to the Director of Budget and Management.

Section 5. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken at open meeting of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the City of Lyndhurst because the County Treasurer must have this Legislation in hand prior to the disbursement of CARES Act Funding. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
