**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1  
WITH EQUIX INTEGRITY, INC. FOR THE 2019 SEWER  
INSPECTION & CLEANING PROGRAM, AUTHORIZING  
THE CLOSEOUT OF SAID CONTRACT, AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City has previously entered a Contract with Equix Integrity, Inc., for the 2019 Sewer Inspection & Cleaning Program: and

**WHEREAS**, Equix Integrity, Inc., has successfully completed the Contract, and the contract can be closed out and the retainer released; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to enter into a Change Order as set forth herein in order to initiate and complete the close out procedure, Now, therefore;

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDBURST,  
CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a Change Order Contract with Equix Integrity Inc., for the credit amount of Eighteen Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Six Dollars and Sixty-One Cents (\$18,326.61), in addition to the Contract heretofore authorized by the Board of Control and this Council, as and for final reconciliation of Contract quantities of said Contract, as more fully set forth in Change Order No. 1, dated January 18, 2021, which is fully incorporated herein. The City Engineer has approved the aforesaid Change Order.

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to credit the amount provided for in Section 1 of this Ordinance upon passage hereof and execution of the Change Order authorized herein and completion of the work.

**SECTION 3.** This Council determines that the work included in the Contract with Equix Integrity Inc., has been completed, and the contract may be closed out, and the retainage released, pursuant to the application and certificate for final payment, the final Contract price, including additions and deletions, being Three Hundred Five Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Dollars and Eighty-Nine Cents (\$305,840.89). This final payment amount has been approved by the City Engineer.

**SECTION 4.** The Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to complete the closeout of this Contract in accordance with this ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Lyndhurst and its residents for the reason that it is necessary to approve the aforesaid changes so as to not unnecessarily delay the completion of the aforesaid Project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council, and signature by the Mayor, or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 48 WITH GREENSPACE CONSTRUCTION SERVICES (GCS) FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT EXPANSION AND RENOVATION PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City has previously entered a Contract with Greenspace Construction Services (GCS) for the Fire Department Expansion and Renovation Project; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to enter a Change Order as set forth herein due to needed additions to the Contract or unforeseen circumstances associated with the Contract. Now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNDHURST, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to enter into a Change Order Contract with Greenspace Construction Services to complete bracing of the new basement masonry wall, in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Sixty-Five Cents (\$3,695.65), in addition to the Contract heretofore authorized by this Council, all as more fully set forth in GCS Change Order No. PCCO#48, dated January 28, 2021, which is fully incorporated herein. The Design Architect has approved the aforesaid Change Order.

**SECTION 2.** The Director of Finance be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay the amount provided for in Section 1 of this Ordinance upon passage hereof and execution of the Change Order authorized herein and completion of the work.

**SECTION 3.** The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Ordinance have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
