### *Writing History: Not Just Books*

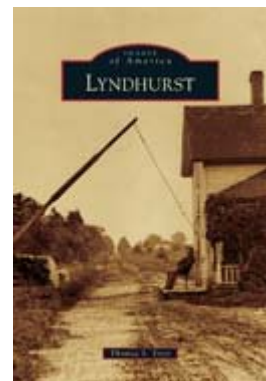
