## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

### **Camberly Dr., Aldersgate Dr., Edenhall Dr. and Cornwall Ln.**

#### **Dear Resident:**

Starting **May 27<sup>th</sup>**, pavement repair work will begin on your street. This work is part of the \$294,760 Concrete Repair Program being done in the City this year. The City's contractor for this year's program is A&J Cement Contractors, Inc. The streets will be worked on in this order: Edenhall, Aldersgate, Camberly, with Cornwall in between. The work should take 5 weeks in total.

The work will involve replacing the deteriorated concrete joints and slabs on these streets. If your drive needs to be blocked for the work, the Contractor will notify you in advance. If you need to park overnight on the street in legal parking spots, please call the Police Department at 440-442-1234 to let them know you are leaving your vehicle out overnight so you are not ticketed.

During the work, the streets will be posted that they are open for Local Traffic Only. **Camberly Dr.** will have **ONE-WAY TRAFFIC ONLY**, in the southbound direction, from Golfway to Kilbourne. Please plan your travels accordingly. It is possible the other streets will have one-way traffic, but we don't know this at this time.

**Please put your garbage, recyclables and branches out by 7 am on their normally scheduled day. If you have sprinklers or buried dog fence in your treelawn, please mark them or let a worker or the Inspector know.** Please proceed slowly through the construction areas. If you see the workers hosing down the street, they are washing cement slurry from saw cutting, let them finish the area so you don't get cement paste on your car.

Thank you for your cooperation during this work. We regret the temporary inconvenience all this work may cause you. Please be patient and cooperative, and the inconveniences can be minimized. Also, if there are any areas on your tree lawn that are seeded due to the work, please water these areas so the grass will grow properly.
