Rain Barrel Workshop on June 4th at Cleveland Metroparks Acacia Reservation

Lyndhurst, OH – Learn how to harvest rainwater for all of your garden needs and to combat storm water pollution in your community by constructing a rain barrel! Cleveland Metroparks, Cuyahoga Soil and Water Conservation District, City of Lyndhurst and Friends of Euclid Creek are hosting a Rain Barrel Workshop Saturday, June 4th from 9:30-11:00am at the Cleveland Metroparks Acacia Reservation (26899 Cedar Road, 44124). The \$60 fee includes a 60 gallon barrel, all materials and downspout diverter. Registration is required by Monday, May 30.

A rain barrel is a container used to collect and store rainwater that would otherwise be lost to runoff and likely diverted to a storm drain. Collected water may then be used to water lawns and gardens.
