Volunteers Urgently Needed for the Following Positions in Your Community:

Blood Transportation Specialist

Deliver life-saving blood products from collection sites to processing lab and/or to hospital.

Commitment: 2 shifts (4-6 hour shifts) per month

Disaster Action Team Member

Assist individuals and families who have been impacted by a home fire or local other disaster.

Commitment: monthly oncall shift

Blood Donor Ambassador (age 16+)

Help Save lives in your community by supporting blood collection at a local blood drive.

Commitment: 1+ shift (5-6 hour shifts) per month for 3 - 6 months

SAF Hero Care Regional Caseworker

Ensure military families' needs are met when faced with an emergency.

Commitment: 2-4 hours per week
